

Xh Series Length Selection Guide

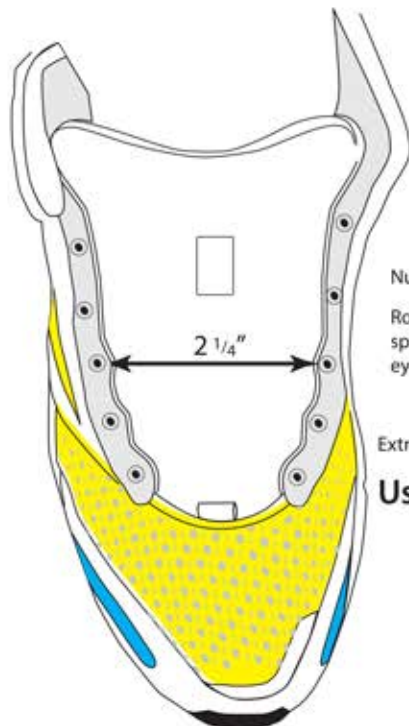


To determine the proper Xh Series lace length for your shoes:

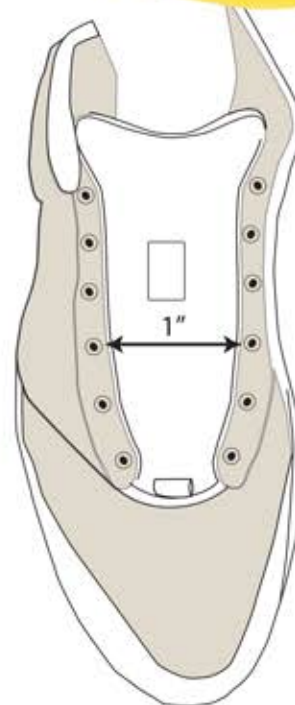
- Total Eyelets:** Count the total number of eyelets on both sides of one shoe.
- Distance Between Eyelets + 6":** With your foot in the shoe, measure the space between the eyelets across the tongue. (Note: always round-up to the next whole number (inch/centimeter) when measuring eyelet spacing.)
- Using the guide below select the proper length for your shoes.
